On Thursday, June 19 you can catch following the "Free Stages" and Opening ceremonies from 10:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., the first headlining act the "Shuffle Demons", at the Lazy Owl.

Friday, June 20 the "Free Stages continue from 9:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. with numerous talented local groups. The Anthony D'Alessandro Quintet featuring Benny Benack performs that evening at the Lazy Owl. Then on Monday evening June 23 come back to the Lazy Owl and enjoy Canada's Juno winning stars with the Christine Jensen Quartet, as the last concert at the Lazy Owl.
